Present Continuous (Interrogative Form. Yes/No Questions)

Am I listening to music now?

Yes, you are.

No, you're not.

No, you aren't.

Are you watching a movie on TV right now?

Yes, I am.

No, I am not.

No, I'm not.

Is he speaking on the phone at the moment?

Yes, he is.

No, he is not

No, he's not.

No, he isn't.



Present Continuous

(Interrogative Form. Yes/No Questions)

*Is she **studying** English in her bedroom now?*

Yes, she is.

No, she's not.

No, she isn't.

*Is it **eating** its food? Is the dog **eating** its food?*

Yes, it is.

No, it's not

No, it isn't.

*Are we **having** lunch together now?*

Yes, you are.

No, you're not.

No, you aren't.

Present Continuous

(Interrogative Form. Yes/No Questions)

Are you playing videogames?

Yes, we are.

No, we're not.

No, we aren't.

Are they dancing at the moment?

Yes, they are.

No, they're not.

No, they aren't.
